

Waterski Scoring – Scoring for a multi-lake competition

To score a competition on 2 (or more) lakes, follow those instructions:

1) The main scoring file (the file you created for that competition) is called the “Master file”.



- in this master file, enter all skiers, event schedule
- **define for each event on which lake it will take place**
- always make or change start lists in the master file
- always do all corrections (names, scores...) in the master file

2) To score on a 2nd lake (or 3rd...) one or more scheduled events :

- Close the master file
- Copy the master file on another computer (via USB key) that will be used to score on the 2nd lake. This file is our "2nd file".
- The 2nd scorer can score on the 2nd lake as usual, including live scoring


3) At the end of the event(s) on 2nd lake:

- close the 2nd file. (Don't do any start lists for next round from the 2nd file)
- copy the 2nd file on a USB key
- from the master computer, close the master file, and make a backup of the file (just in case ...)
- open the master file
- go to **menu "File", "Import scores..."** to open the "import score" window
 - (1) Select the 2nd file to import on USB key to import
 - (2) Select the event(s) to import
 - (3) click on "Import scores" to start import

The imported scores will be shown as this:



Important:

Only scores NOT PRESENT in the master file will be imported from the 2nd file.

which means, when you have imported the scores, any correction made in the 2nd file will NOT be imported anymore, unless you clear the scores of that event in the master file and import again.

4) To score other event(s) on another lake:

- do again point 2) and 3): copy the master file...

NB1: you can import scores only from a file issued from the same competition (codes should be identical)

NB2: backup your scoring file before and after importing scores, in case something get wrong

SurePath :

- In SurePath, you have to choose the "sub ID" as "Lake 1", "Lake 2", "Lake 3"...
